## **Boy Scout Builds Planters for Local Facility**

Michael Watkins Completes Eagle Scout Project for Broad Mountain


**Frackville**, **PA** – Michael Watkins, a boy scout from Troop 780, recently built and donated planters to Broad Mountain Health & Rehabilitation Center. He created this service project for his Eagle Scout award, which is

the highest achievement in the Boy Scouts of America (BSA) program.

Watkins told us his grandmother gave him the idea to volunteer and build the planters. She explained that Broad Mountain's old flower beds were torn down, so it became his mission to replace them with beautiful planters.

To create the planters, Watkins had to measure how big they'd be, researched what kind of wood lasts the longest, and make them accessible to residents in wheelchairs. He also took the initiative to gather volunteers for the project.

"I asked friends and family who worked in construction to help out. We also took into account our COVID-19 limitations such as wearing masks and building in the garage where it was well ventilated," Watkins said.





Watkins shared with us that at 15, he taught environmental science to children to obtain one of his merit badges. This badge helped him build his work ethic as well as his independence and leadership.

"Scouting has taught me how to survive in the wilderness and gives me a community to go to. I've also learned how to adapt to different environments. There's many things scouting has to offer," he said.
